All events must include a 4-digit code number. This code number will be used by the contest host to create schedules and check-out forms. The Director is responsible for using the proper codes. Please follow the instructions below.

- The first two (2) digits of each event code are to correspond with the codes listed above.  
Example: Alto Saxophone = 07. Violin = 22 Female Voice = 26
- The second two (2) digits of each event code will indicate the number of students in the event.  
Example: Alto Saxophone Solo = 0701 [Alto Saxophone(07) & Solo(01)]  
Violin Trio = 2203 [Violin(22) & Trio(3)]  
Female Double Duet = 2604 [Female Voice(26) & Double Duet(4)]
- Be sure to use the proper code for mixed ensembles.  
Example: Saxophone Quartet = 2904 [Mixed WW Ens(29) & Quartet(04)]  
Brass Choir = 3012 [Mixed Brass Ens(30) & 12 Members(12)]  
String Quartet = 3304 [Mixed String Ens(33) & Quartet (04)]  
Madrigal Choir = 3412 [Mixed Vocal Ens(34) & 12 members (12)]  
Percussion Ensemble = 3107 [Perc. Ens(31) & 7 members (07)]
